To that end, I have secured the opportunity for one hundred couples from our POTC gathering of believers (prayer chain) to gather at either one of two retreat centers that are part of the Officers Christian Fellowship Ministry. These venues will permit each of us, along with our spouses to enjoy three nights and four days, with three served meals a day, for a total investment of \$550.00 for two people or \$275.00 for one person. (taxes and gratuity included.) This rate has been lowered substantially because of the generosity of one of our comrades and his wife. May I ask you to consider attending an early Summer retreat at White Sulphur Springs in Bedford, PA or an early Fall retreat at Spring Canyon Retreat in Buena Vista, CO? Certainly, you can attend either one or both. (Travel expenses will be reimbursed on the other

We are ramping up our mission to share Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior with the remaining 640 or so classmates from 1974.
